System Requirements

The system requirements for Magnitude Angles Hub 22.2 are as follows.

⚠ Important: Make sure that you have the latest service packs and updates for Magnitude Angles Hub 22.2 and related products.

Prerequisites

The prerequisite for installing and using Magnitude Angles Hub 22.2 is Magnitude NoetixViews (NoetixViews) (Global forms of the views) of Version 6.6 or later.

Server Computer Requirements

The following table lists the hardware requirements.

Components	Recommended
Processor	Multiple processors or a single processor with multiple cores
RAM	16 GB
Disk Space	1-6 GB, depending on application size

The software requirements are as follows:

- **Microsoft Internet Information Services (IIS):** 10, 8.5, or 8.0

ⓘ Note: We recommend you enable Web Deploy and WebSocket Protocol in [IIS](#).

- **Web browser:** Google Chrome 79.0.3945.130 or later
- **Oracle client software:** Version 11.2 or later, including SQL*Plus and Oracle Data Provider for .NET (ODP.NET)

ⓘ Note: We recommend Oracle client software version 12C. The bitness of the Oracle client must match with that of the operating system. The `TNS_ADMIN` environment variable must be set to the location of the `tnsnames.ora` file.

- **ASP.NET Core Runtime 3.1:** Go to <https://dotnet.microsoft.com/> > Downloads > NET Core 3.1 > All .NET Core downloads > .Net Core 3.1 > 3.1.19 > ASP.NET Core 3.1 Runtime 3.1.19 -Windows x64 Installer
- **ASP.NET Core 3.1- Windows Hosting Bundle:** Go to <https://dotnet.microsoft.com/> > Downloads > NET Core 3.1 > All .NET Core downloads > .Net Core 3.1 > 3.1.19 > ASP.NET Core 3.1 Runtime 3.1.19 -Windows Hosting Bundle Installer
- Elasticsearch 6.8.22 (available as a part of the Angles Hub software installer)

Note: Install a compatible Java (JRE) and make sure the environment variables (`JAVA_HOME` and `PATH`) are updated correctly to avoid installation issues.

The software requirements for Magnitude Angles Hub 22.2 are as follows:

- **Web browser:** Google Chrome 79.0.3945.130 or later
- **BI Tools:** Microsoft Power BI Desktop 2.79 or later, Tableau 2020.2.0 or later
- **Microsoft Excel:** Microsoft Excel 2019 or later

What's New

The new features and enhancements to Magnitude Angles Hub 22.2 are as follows.

New Features

Enabled Single Sign-On for Excel reporting for Oracle EBS

While logged into Angles Hub using single sign-on, you can now create and execute Excel reports. You can achieve this by configuring the appropriate OpenID Connect (OIDC) application using the **Add New** option available under *<Your Username>* > **Administrator** > **Identity Provider Configuration** > **OpenID Connect Applications**.

Generate semantic layer (RPD) using OAC generator in Angles Hub

You can generate semantic layer (RPD) file for the workspaces in Angles Hub, to get a head-start for reporting with Oracle Analytics Cloud.

Support for SSL-enabled Oracle databases

When the Oracle EBS database is secured or configured with SSL, the Angles Hub will support TNS service connectivity.

Fixed Issues

The fixed issues in Magnitude Angles Hub 22.2 are as follows:

Add workspaces with the same name for different connections

When you tried to add workspaces with the same name to two different connections, an error message similar to the following was displayed:

```
"Another application with the same name already exists."
```

Importing report, view failed because of non-existent workspace

When you try to import views or reports into a non-existing workspace, an error message similar to the following was displayed:

```
"Workspace not available."
```

License activation

The license for Angles Hub was not activated for some customers. To enable license activation, support for proxy server configuration is included in Angles Hub.

Tasks take longer time to complete

When you try to run a task, such as generating an Excel report or deploying a view, the task runs longer than expected. You can use the **Abort** button on the **Task Monitor** page to end the current task.
